進入暴風眼

2008年對全世界各國領袖而言，是一個驚慌又難捱的一年，最主要的是人類共同碰上了數十年來首見的全球能源危機，及以美國為首的金融大風暴。幾個月來，全球的政治領袖，金融主管，企業的CEO，無不跳出來焦頭爛額的做危機處理。全球多數人也都面臨財產縮水，物價騰升，景氣不佳，工作不保等惡劣環境。再加上大陸的毒奶粉事件，台灣的颱風，土石流，前總統的貪瀆案件，新政府表現不佳，以致人心惶惶。一些趨勢專家甚至斷言這股全球的大蕭條危機，短期內還不會結束，一些壞消息，情緒性的宣洩言詞與脫軌行為，更增添人們浮躁、焦慮的氣氛，我們台福教會與世界各地政治、經濟、社會生活息息相關，自然會受到這股悲觀與躁動的經濟風暴所影響。

在每個大風暴、颶風、龍捲風的中心點都有一個地方叫暴風眼。這個暴風眼跟整個周遭的狂亂環境是完全不同的，一旦進入暴風眼突然會變得出奇的平靜與安全，使處在暴風中的人得到舒緩與安靜。飽經人生歷練的大衛王曾說：「洪水氾濫之時，耶和華坐著為王，耶和華坐著為王，直到永遠，耶和華必賜力量給他的百姓，耶和華必賜平安的福，給

他的百姓。」(詩 29:10-11)。美國神學家查弗(Lewis Sperry Chafer)曾說：基督徒當活得比世人實在與樂觀。因基督徒知道 1.神是全知的 2.神是全能的 3.神是慈愛的，且是愛我的。我們當相信神仍在掌權，神允許許多事情陸續發生，背後仍有其計畫與美意，神更是要他的百姓在艱難中學會一些寶貴的功課。

在這多災多難，人心翻騰的2008年逐漸遠離之際，我們當花更多時間共同為世界各地領袖、國家與美國即將在11月舉行的總統選舉禱告，學習在經濟、政治風暴中仍專注在神的引領與應許上，常進入全知、全能、慈愛之神的「恩典風暴眼中」，冷靜的傾聽神聲音，真實的為罪悔改，謙卑的明白神旨意，在節能減炭中操練儉樸生活，適時的為渴慕，受苦的人伸出援手，在艱難中繼續在各地做彼此勸勉，安慰與鼓勵的工作，堅守個人在家庭、工作、教會中的服事崗位，求神賜下智慧、謀略，攜手同心的靠主恩典走出這場前所未有的大風暴。

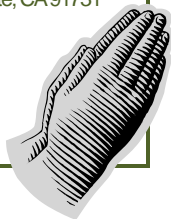

Entering the Eye of the Storm

2008 has been a turbulent and difficult year for many people all around the globe. The main causes of concern are the *oil crisis* which we have not encountered in the past few decades, and the *financial crisis* that originated from the United States but soon affected the whole world. In the past several months, political leaders, Chiefs of Finance sectors, and CEOs of private enterprises all have been spending much time and resources attempting to resolve the crises in this critical time. However, not only the government officials or the CEOs have been worrying; the general public is facing difficulties in their day-to-day lives as well. There are threats of depreciation of asset values and inflation, there are fears of an economic recession and the increased prices of commodities, and there are reports of raising unemployment rates and other bad news reports. Moreover, the incident of tainted milk formula from China, the destructive typhoons hitting Taiwan, the mud flows and landslides that caused tremendous damages, the corruption scandal of the former Taiwanese president, and the low performance of the new government all resulted in heightened anxieties in people's hearts. On top of that, some trend analysts even forecasted that the worldwide recession that we have seen so far will not be getting any better in the near future. Since our EFC churches are tightly connected to the local political affairs, economics, and society, these grim news events have inevitably had an impact on us.

Every storm, typhoon, or tornado, has a center area called the "eye". This area is completely different from the chaos surrounding it. Once one enters the "eye of the storm", one would feel unexpectedly peaceful and safe

despite the storm around it. King David who had experienced much hardship in his life said, "The LORD sits enthroned over the flood; the LORD is enthroned as King forever. The LORD gives strength to his people; the LORD blesses his people with peace." (Psalm 29:10-11). American theologian Lewis Sperry Chafer once said that Christians should live a more optimistic life than non-Christians because we know that 1. God is omniscient; 2. God is omnipotent; and 3. God is merciful and He loves us. Even in times like this, we should know that God is still in control. He allows these things to happen for a purpose and a plan. He wants us to learn the lesson of "trust" when we are facing difficulties.

As this tumultuous year comes to an end in a few weeks, I encourage you to spend more time praying for the leaders around the world. Even more so now, since the US presidential election will take place in November. Let us learn to enter the "eye" of the political/financial storm that is protected by the omniscient, omnipotent and merciful God. Let us trust His guidance and focus on His promises. Let us learn to quiet down our hearts in order to listen to His voice; to genuinely repent for our sins; to seek to understand God's will with humble hearts; to practice living a simple life; and to help those who are suffering. In such a time like this, let us remember to strengthen, comfort, and encourage one another; to stand firm and continue to serve our families, workplaces and churches. Finally, let us pray that God will grant us the wisdom and discernment to weather this unprecedented storm and walk out united together.

EFCGA Ministry Summary 2008 2nd ~ 3rd Quarter

- This year the EFCGA has a new team, taking up the responsibility of passing on the vision and meeting challenges.
- The new team is for reinforcing the function of the Regional Meeting, as well as solidifying the relationship between the Regional Meeting and local churches, and has thus introduced the following projects:
 - The weekly electronic news bulletin – From each region 2~3 weekly news articles will be chosen and posted to the GA website for all members to view.
 - The monthly video tape – to benefit all churches in strengthening their relations to the EFCGA and it's organizations
 - Quarterly telephone conference – To strengthen the contact between the EFCGA, Regional Meeting, and local churches
- The new EFCGA Secretary General, Pr. Peter Chen, in period between July and August, visited most of the churches and Evangelism stations in Taiwan
